(Early Reading/Sight Words/Name Recognition)	Cupid Couples: Students will match upper and lowercase letters to find their pair. (Letter Recognition)

(Science)	Conversation Heart Math: Students will practice math equations and counting with conversation heart candies. (Number Recognition/Counting/Math)	Hearts of All Sizes: Students will use various tools to measure valentines. (Number Recognition/Measuring Skills)	20 Little Valentine's: Students will practice counting backwards and quantifying with this valentine themed song. (Music/Rhythm/Counting/Number Identification)	Lovely Patterns: Students will create colorful patterns using conversation heart candy. (Sorting/Color Recognition/Pattern Creation)
Music, Arts, Fine & Gross Motor	Full Heart Valentine's: Create Valentine poetry art using various art supplies. (Fine Motor/Early Reading/Art)	Heart Art: Students will tear paper to create heart collages. (Art/Fine Motor)	Today is Valentine's Day: Students will learn a song and dance to the tune of The Farmer and the Dell. (Music/Rhythm/Following Directions/Gross Motor)	Valentine Yoga: Students will practice valentine themed yoga exercises. (Gross Motor)	Little Love Monsters: Students will cut and paste to create cute "love monster" art. (Art/Fine Motor)
