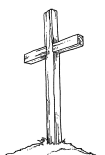
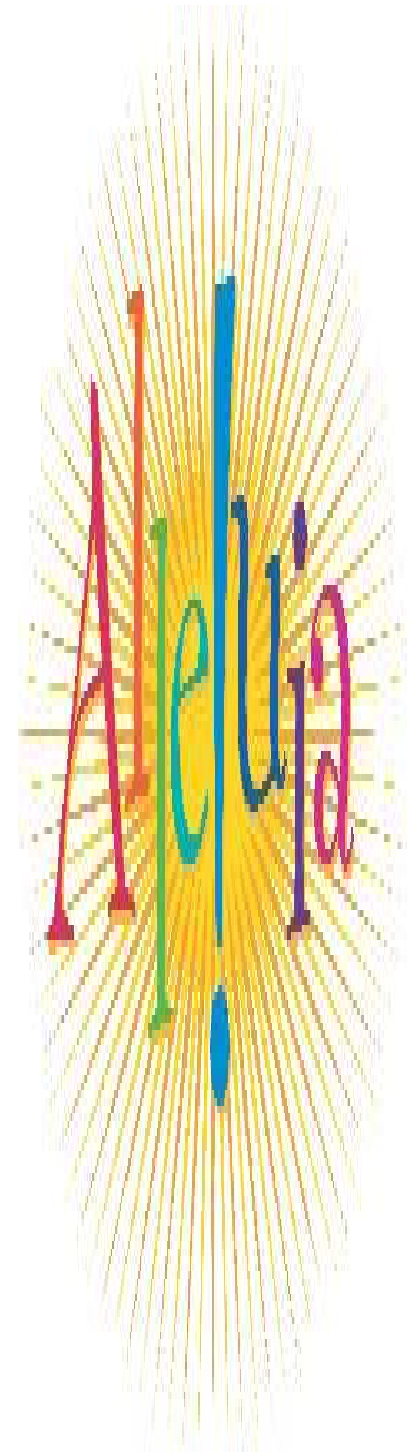
**Vigil of Easter,**

## Call Committee

### UPDATE...

After meeting and interviewing the most recent candidate provided by the Synod, the Call Committee presented a candidate to the Council for their consideration.

The next step in the call process is for the Council to interview the candidate. The process continues to require confidentiality as it relates to any information about the candidate. If you have any questions about the process please feel free to ask a member of Council.

Thank you for your continued patience and prayers as we continue along our journey together to find a new pastor.

We've probably heard all of these expressions recently, and it seems to be a good opportunity to use all of them to let you know what's ahead in our Justice Ministry for the next year. The **BUILD** Rally was held on March 23 in preparation for the Nehemiah Assembly that is scheduled for April 21 (Tuesday) at 7:00 pm. It will be held in Heritage Hall and you may use the High Street as well as the Cox Street lot for parking. This will be an historical event for several reasons. First, we anticipate that 2,000 people will be attending. Secondly, we have invited the five senators who represent Fayette counties in the State Senate to hear our plans for payday reform, and to thank Senator Alice Forgy-Kerr for her sponsorship and support of PDL legislation. And thirdly, we will have follow-up from Mayor Gray and the City Council regarding the progress of the affordable Housing Fund. You will also learn what the steering committee working on violent crime has been doing over the past several months. Justice has made some much needed steps forward, and YOU NEED TO BE THERE to insure that we continue to make that forward progress.

Certainly, one of the lessons we learned recently is that fighting a well-financed opponent is *very* difficult. The PDL industry has millions of dollars at their disposal, and we learned that they use it effectively when they need to do so. We do, however, have a couple of reliable tools to use. One of those is education, and we will continue our goal to educate every senator about the predatory nature of payday lending, the usurious rates that are charged and the psychological, economic and moral impact that payday lending leaves in its wake. We also know that there is power in numbers and for that reason, your participation is most crucial. You are needed to attend the Nehemiah Action, to call you senator and representative, to tell your friends, neighbors and relatives the PDL story and encourage their support as well. If payday lending and the experience the people of Kentucky had as justice (through a 36% rate cap) was denied, does not make you angry.... I don't know what to say.

Also, please note that we are approaching the season of the **BUILD** investment drive. The work of **BUILD** cannot happen without investments of time, energy, emotion, prayer and, yes, money. Your investment will pay salaries for our three organizers, office space and general operating expenses, and most importantly your investment pays for training that we receive at the local, regional and national level. Our investment goal for this year is \$9,000, a small sum indeed when the outcome is affordable housing for those who need it, an end to loan-sharking by the payday lending industry and a safer Lexington for you and your children.



Dear friends at Faith,
